



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

DELAWARE COMPENSATION RATING BUREAU FILING NUMBER 2007

INSURANCE COMMISSIONER TRINIDAD NAVARRO hereby gives notice that a VIRTUAL PUBLIC HEARING will be held on **Monday, October 19, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. prevailing Eastern Time**, at the Delaware Department of Insurance, 1351 West North Street, Suite 101, Dover, Delaware 19904. The purpose of the hearing is to consider whether the Delaware Compensation Rating Bureau (DCRB) Filing Number 2007 dated August 21, 2020, complies with applicable law and should be allowed to go into effect, or whether the filing should be disapproved. The filing requests a reduction of 4.36% in Residual Market Rates and a reduction of 7.26% in Voluntary Market Loss Costs. The filing is publicly available on the DCRB website at http://www.dcrb.com/shared/d_contents.htm and by request to the Delaware Department of Insurance.

The hearing will be conducted pursuant to applicable law, including without limitation, 18 *Del. C.* §§ 2605 and 2610 and 29 *Del. C.* §§10121-29. The docket number assigned to this hearing is 4376-2020. A party has the right to present evidence, be represented by Delaware counsel, and appear personally or by other representative. The Delaware Department of Insurance is obligated to reach its decision based on the evidence received.

Comments are being solicited from any person. Comments may be in writing or may be presented orally at the Hearing. Written comments must be received **no later than Monday, October 12, 2020 by 4:30 p.m.** and should be addressed to the attention of Leslie W.
